

## Courses and Entry Requirements 2021-2022

The general entry requirement for Trinity Sixth Form is five or more Grade 5-9 (or equivalent) including grade 4 in English & Maths.

For students wishing to take vocational qualifications **only** five or more Grade 4-9 (or equivalent) is accepted.

If students have achieved a grade 3 in English or Maths, they can re-sit this qualification alongside a more vocational Level 3 pathway.

### A-Level Courses

It is recommended that students have a Level 6 at GCSE in their chosen subject/closely related subject.

Places are available on A Level courses to these students in the first instance.

Exception: Further Maths - Grade 7 at GCSE

### GCSE Mathematics & English

- Students will be required to retake Mathematics or English GCSE qualifications if they have not been achieved at GCSE Grade 4 or above.

Students will need to have achieved a grade 3 to access the resit GCSE Mathematics and English courses.
