# SOCIAL CARE

## Course Content

Level 3 Health and Social Care qualification is a course that can help prepare students for a career in health and social care. It covers a range of topics, including:

- Work Experience: Students may get the chance to work in a variety of settings, such as hospitals, residential homes, and day-care centres
- Communication: Students learn to develop effective communication skills
- Students learn about professional development and how to enhance their hard and soft skills
- Diversity, equality, and rights for all people in society
- Psychology and sociology and how they relate to health and social care
- Human Anatomy and physiology
- The role of public health in keeping the nation healthy
- Nutrition and how it relates to health and social care
- Duty of care across different areas within the health and social care professions.
- Mental capacity and the impact on treatment
- Some courses may also include safeguarding, life-stage development, and health education.
